Local HUD-approved housing counseling agencies – Asian-American Homeownership Counseling (AAHC), Latino Economic Development Center, Housing Initiative Partnership, and First Home Alliance – are collaborating with the area’s largest mortgage servicers to offer free foreclosure prevention services to you. We will also have attorneys available to answer legal questions you may have.

Together, we’ll explore options like modifications, repayment plans forbearance or other resolutions that may help you to better afford your mortgage payment and remain in your home.
